Extension Description

Menu - is a key navigation element for customers on your website. It is particularly important that the menu would contain a maximum of all information, namely that which is needed by your potential customers. Alas, based on analysis of user behavior on large portals, the attention of given only for the first 10% - 20% of all categories of the store directories.

The remaining elements are simply not visible to users and are not used. Shop can increase profits by changing the sitemenu - users should see all items of your catalog products immediately. It is necessary that information was available at the first click.

And this menu allows you to fully control/edit the store catalog displaying type.

- **Menu does not use Nested navigation, all sub-categories are visible initially.**
- **Ability to add description/content directly in the menu section (description, pictures, flash, etc.)**
- **Create custom arbitrary menu items.**
- **Paste inside menu : widgets, static blocks, text, shapes, images, video and all kind of content you have**
- **Modify and customize each type of menu item.**
- **Specify size for each menu item from 1 to 5 columns;**
- **Specify the alignment of the menu items and content;**
- **All menu items categories are fully manageable from an administrative part.**
- **All menu items are fully manageable from an administrative part**
- **The menu is original, with 2 completely different design, a minimalist red and strong blue.**
- **Design the menu is made in conformance standards of html and CSS3 CSS3**
- **phtml and CSS code opened for editing.**

Extension Installation

We made tests on all major installations and this extension is a fully workable. But It is highly recommended to backup your server files and database before installing this module. It is also recommended you install on a test server initially to carry out your own testing.

To install Menu follow this steps:

1 Clear the store cache under var/cache and all cookies for your store domain

2 Disable Compilation Mode (if enabled)

3 Log out from Magento Admin panel if you are logged in

4 Unpack the contents of the “extension” folder from the package file to your Magento root directory

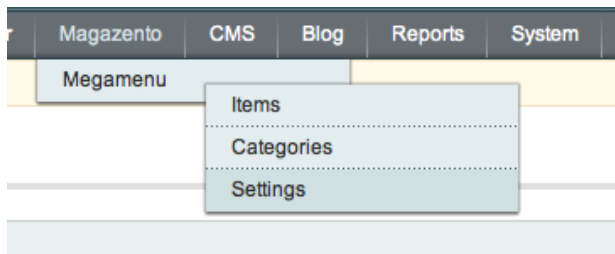
If you dont use “default” folder as your theme pool directory copy files from app/design/frontend/default/default/ & skin/frontend/default/default to yours

5 Check that magento has permissions to read extensions files.

6 If Cache Control is enabled in Magento go to ‘System > Cache Management’ section, select ‘Refresh’ under ‘All Cache’ drop-down menu and press ‘Save Cache Settings’

Extension Usage

First of all check that all extension files and folders uploaded to the right place, after that Log into Magento Admin panel and go to System > Configuration > Magazento tab > "Megamenu" section to configure the extension main settings

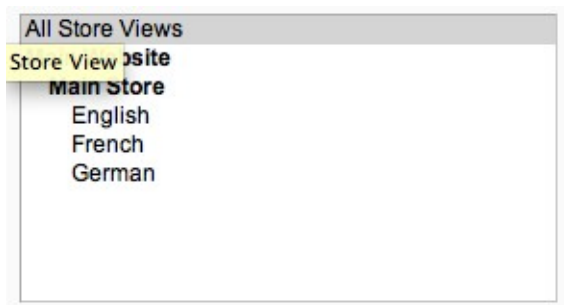

Extension Troubleshooting

After the extension installation the store gives an error, or blank page, or suggests to start Magento installation procedure.

- > Change the owner of the extracted extension files to the web server user and set 775 permissions on them. Clear the store cache and try again.

There is extension tab under configuration section, or having the extension tab clicked I get a blank page, or *Access Denied* error.

- > Clear the store cache, browser cookies, logout and login again.

I've set up everything correctly, inserted the HTML code but there is nothing on that page.

- > Clear the store cache, clear your browser cache and domain cookies and refresh the page.

My configuration changes do not appear on the store.

- > Clear the store cache, clear your browser cache and domain cookies and refresh the page.

Extension Uninstallation

You can completely disable extension if you

delete `"/app/etc/modules/Magazento_Megamenu.xml"` file or just change `"true"` to `"false"`

But if you want to completely remove this extension from your magento installation follow this steps

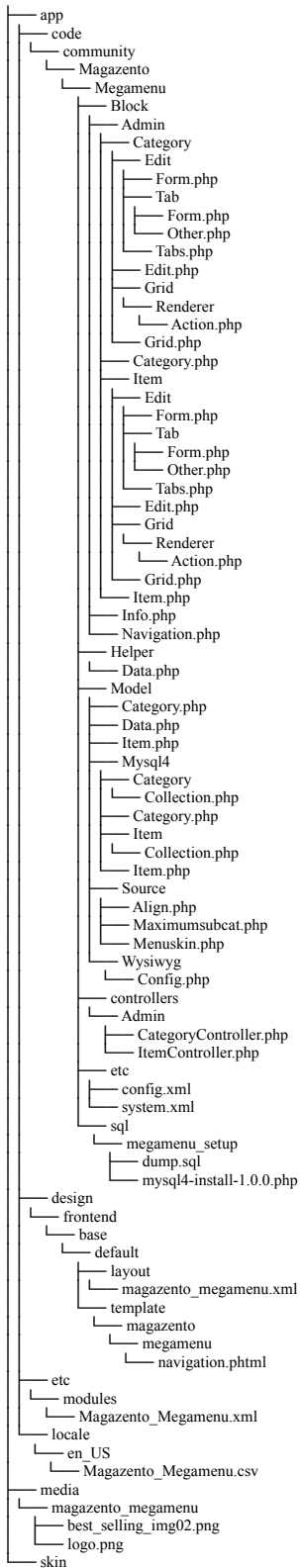
- 1 delete extension files
